Topic.....**Energy Crisis – More than Just the Price at the Pump**

Phil Sharp became President of Resources for the Future (RFF) on September 1, 2005. His career in public service over the last 35 years includes ten terms as a member of the U.S. House of Representatives from Indiana and a lengthy tenure on the faculty of the John F. Kennedy School of Government and as Director of the Institute of Politics at Harvard University. During his 20-year congressional tenure, Sharp took key leadership roles in the development of landmark energy legislation. He helped to develop a critical part of the 1990 Clean Air Act Amendments, was a driving force behind the Energy Policy Act of 1992, and served on several House committees. Dr. Sharp is co-chair of the Energy Board of the Keystone Center and a member of the National Research Council's Board of Energy and Environmental Systems. He serves on the Board of Directors of the Energy Foundation. Sharp received his Ph.D. in government from Georgetown University.
