Kevin Book analyzes and interprets the politics of energy and of the environment as practiced in Washington DC and elsewhere in the world, and how these political developments impact on energy investments. He particularly focuses on policy choices regarding alternative energy and the environment and what they mean for future energy markets. Based on his political-economic analysis of energy and environmental policy, he also forecasts crude oil prices.

Mr. Book is Senior Vice President and Senior Analyst with Friedman, Billings, Ramsey & Co., the owner of FBR Capital Markets. FBR conducts the firm's investment banking, financial advisory, asset management and private wealth businesses. Mr. Book's previous experience includes a senior technology management role at a national financial media company, project leadership for an international professional services firm, and independent consulting to start-up companies, venture capital funds, and the FBI. He frequently appears on television and is quoted in the print media, including Barron's, the NY Times, the Washington Post and Congressional Quarterly.

Mr. Book holds an MA in Law & Diplomacy from the Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy and a BA in Economics from Tufts University.
